WHAT IS CERT TRAINING?

CERT Training is a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) training class. The CERT basic training class educates new members about disaster preparedness for the hazards that will impact Soboba and trains them in basic disaster response skills such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization and disaster medical operations.

COMPLETION

Upon completion of the 20-hour training, participants will receive a certificate of completion and CERT supplies.
