WHAT IS TERT/CERT TRAINING?

CERT Training is a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) training class. The CERT basic training class educates new members about disaster preparedness for the hazards that will impact your community and train you in basic disaster response skills such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization and disaster medical operations.

COMPLETION

Upon completion of all 3 days, and all units and exercises, participants will receive a certificate and CERT backpacks.
